Photo Search General Rules

- 1. Photos must be taken by the member making the entry.
- 2. Each entry will consist of:

a. A photo print (no larger than 5" X 7") with the member's name, school, grade, county and title of photo on the back of the photo.

b. One completed entry form per photo must accompany each photo entry.

4.Photos should relate to 4-H involvement. Entries may be a single photo or a series of no more than four photos. A series may be "before and after" or "how-to-do-it" sequences.

5. Entry photos should **not** be matted or mounted on any type of paper.

- 6. Entries will be judged on quality and message. The picture might depict:
 - * 4-H project work
 - * 4-H exhibits, shows, fairs, etc.
 - * 4-H leadership/citizenship.
 - * Leisure education, camp, etc.
 - * Human interest and other

7. All entries will become the property of Tennessee 4-H Youth Development and will not be returned to the 4-H member unless otherwise requested.

Failure to meet any of the entry procedures or general rules will disqualify the photo search entry.

Due Date:

March 31st

** Please keep an electronic file of the photo you enter! **

County winning photos will be sent on to the state level. Winners will be individually contacted and asked to come to the 4-H office at a later date.

In order to enter at the state, students MUST send in an electronic copy as well. The resolution of the photo sent electronically should be 2400 x 3000 (pixels) so we can make an 8 x 10 copy should the entry win.
