

4-H Poster Contest

Rules:

- Posters must be made by the 4-H'er.
- Posters must be horizontal only.
- Posters must be 14 X 22 inches. (a half a sheet of poster board)
- Name, school, and grade of the 4-H member should be clearly written on the back of each poster.
- 4-H is to be the topic for the poster.
- Must include the 4-H Emblem. Please, do not place text or other images over or on top of it. The 4-H
 Emblem should not appear screened under words or graphics. No photo, drawing, symbol, word or other
 figure or object maybe be placed on or obscure the 4-H Emblem.
- No copyrighted material may be used.
- Three dimensional objects or materials which extend **1/8 inch or more above the surface** of the poster may not be used.
- Absolutely no glitter
